***THE PERFECT ASHLAR AWARD  
2010***



There are many Master Masons throughout the Grand Jurisdiction of Virginia whose exemplary efforts for the Craft enhance the image of Freemasonry both in the Lodge and in the community.

The newly established Perfect Ashlar Award was presented to one of these deserving Brethren for the first time at the 1984 Grand Annual Communication.

Initial nominations for the Perfect Ashlar Award will be made by the Worshipful Masters.

The award will be limited to a living Virginia Mason who is NOT a Past Master and who is NOT currently serving in an elected officer's position. The Worshipful Master will thoughtfully consider the Brethren in his Masonic District whose lives best represent the ideals of Freemasonry.

The nominee need not be from the Worshipful Master's Lodge. Nominations are, however, restricted to the Worshipful Master's District. The nomination form must be completed, dated, and signed by the Worshipful Master. Each Worshipful Master is requested to keep his selection in strict confidence.

Unselfish service, brotherhood, absolute fidelity to the Craft in word and deed, willingness to serve, as well as the ability to communicate harmony are some of the qualities to be considered in selecting the Brother to be nominated for the Perfect Ashlar Award.

The District Deputy Grand Master will review the Nomination forms from their respective Districts, selecting no more than two of the nominees submitted by the Worshipful Masters of the District. These nominations must be forwarded to the District Deputy Grand Master no later than **September 1st**.

The District Deputy Grand Masters are also required to sign these Nomination forms and submit them to the Grand Lodge office no later than **October 1st**.

The Perfect Ashlar Award Committee will review all nominations submitted, selecting three nominees whose qualifications distinguish them particularly for this award.

The Most Worshipful Grand Master will make the final selection of that nominee to whom he will present the Perfect Ashlar Award at Grand Lodge.
